COLSA Awarded Digital Integration Lab Task Order

COLSA Corporation has been awarded its second task order under the Simulation and Training Omnibus Contract (STOC II) by the Program Executive Office for Simulation, Training, and Instrumentation (PEO STRI). The Digital Integration Lab (DIL) task order is a one-year award with a value of \$1.6 million. An additional four years are available as options. On the DIL, COLSA will staff and operate a secure and centralized location in support of all PEO STRI programs required to integrate with Army Battle Command Systems (ABCS). The DIL was established to provide a critical risk reduction capability, dedicated to supporting designated customer programs in their preparation for formal Army Interoperability Certification (AIC) testing while supporting respective PEO STRI Project Managers (PMs) during software development and training system integration. COLSA will provide tasks and services which include first line ABCS technical support; ABCS system administration and operator expertise; management of distribution and control of ABCS system hardware and software; support of pre-AIC and formal AIC testing; requirements analysis; systems engineering; integration, test and experimentation; software and hardware evaluation; configuration management; data collection; technical demonstrations; off-site visits and support; and technical analysis.
